

Kovochich Announces Schedule Change for 2007-08 School Year

(July 26, 2007) – Dominican Principal Ed Kovochich has announced a schedule change for the upcoming school year which will cancel out the Monday Options class and add five minutes to each of the Options classes held Tuesday through Friday.

Beginning Aug. 21, the 40-minute Options classes will run from 2:40 p.m. to 3:20 p.m. Students that have faculty-only coaches or advisors will be supervised in the cafeteria for quiet study until 4 p.m. on Mondays.

Options classes are offered to all students, regardless of class level. The one-half credit classes provide students with 36 weeks of study in such diverse areas as photography, digital imaging, chamber choir and strength fitness. During the Options class period, students may also opt for tutoring in specific disciplines such as math or language arts.

Kovochich said the change was made to accommodate Faculty Professional Development sessions which will take place Mondays after school. The additional five minutes added to the Tuesday through Friday Options classes will ensure Dominican meets Department of Public Instruction standards for credit.

“This change will enable all staff to be included in on-going professional development sessions for spirituality and academics, regardless of coaching and/or advisor responsibilities,” said Kovochich. “This simple change will aid in our efforts to continually improve communications within our Dominican community.”
