Recap:

The Knights lost their first conference game of the season to Racine St. Catherine's on January 29<sup>th</sup>, 49-40. Duane Wilson led the team with 16 points, including four three-point field goals. Iman Johnson, who finished with 13, was the only other double-digit scorer for the boys.

Earlier in the week, Dominican beat St. John's Military Academy 53-43 on January 26<sup>th</sup>. In this fast-paced game, the Knights took the lead in the second quarter and maintained it to the end. Wilson scored a team-high 20 points, while Johnson added 12. Tommy Popalisky finished with nine points.
