Recap:

The Knights beat cross town rival Whitefish Bay 46-34 on December 4<sup>th</sup> to pick up their first win of the 2009-2010 season. Dominican built and held a steady lead throughout the game, with Dilonna Johnson (16 points) and Deysha Smith-Jenkins (15 points) leading the way. As a team, the girls shot 73% from the free throw line.
