## **Dominican Valedictorians and Salutatorian Lead Class of 2008**

**WHITEFISH BAY, Wis.** – Dominican High School will hold commencement exercises for the Class of 2008 on Friday, May 23. Co-valedictorians Juan Lozano (left) and Alice Wycklendt are pictured with salutatorian Peter Linn at the Honors Assembly held May 16. All three students received scholarship offers from multiple post-secondary schools of distinction. Lozano of Menomonee Falls plans to attend Stanford University on a \$160,000, four-year scholarship. Wycklendt of Shorewood will attend Marquette University on a full scholarship, and Linn, who resides on Milwaukee's east side, has narrowed his choices down to Marquette, Loyola or Notre Dame.
