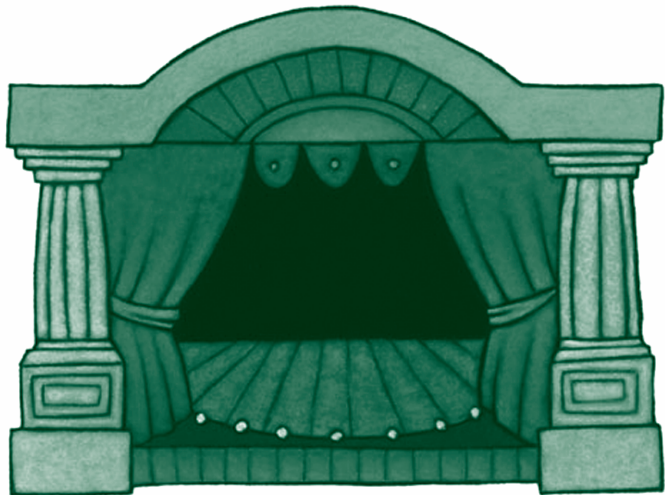
THE GROUNDINGS
