Student Parking Registration 2010-2011

As you know Dominican has limited parking on its property for students in the Silver Spring lot. This form advises students and parents on the process for applying for a student parking spot and the alternatives for students who may not receive a parking spot on campus.

Due to the limited number of parking spaces in the Silver Spring lot, we have enlisted the partnership of the Bay Shore Towne Centre to help provide additional parking spots for all interested students. The spots reserved for DHS students are located in the parking structure on Lydell Avenue level 3. Students are encouraged not to park in Kohl's parking lot, for risk of receiving a citation.

Between **10 and 20** student spots will be available in the Silver Spring lot. Students will be assigned parking spaces using the established criteria listed below.

Criteria that is considered when assigning student parking:

1. Application and **annual parking deposit/fee of \$200** is received **on or before** the deadline of **August 13, 2010**.
2. Student drivers grade level. All factors being equal, *senior applicants receive more consideration than junior applicants.*
3. A formal raffle of students meeting the above two criteria

Please note:

- Typically, 50 applications for parking will be received. Students not receiving a parking assignment will receive a refund of the \$200 registration deposit/fee that was due with the application.
- The parking permit & tag must be displayed whenever it is parked in the **Silver Spring** lot.
- The registered automobile must only be parked in the parking stall for which it has been provided a permit.
- Parking in a parking stall other than the one for which a permit has been assigned may result in one or all of the following:
 1. Assignment of a weekday detention
 2. Dominican fine of \$10.
 3. Whitefish Bay municipal parking ticket of \$15. (Silver Spring or Bay Shore Towne Center structure)
 4. Towing of the vehicle (typically \$75 for the tow, \$15 per day for lot storage).

Please complete the form attached to this letter and return it to Mr. Brian Geittmann by August 13, 2010. Applications that are returned after this date will not be considered. Applicants will be notified of their parking status at Orientation Day.
